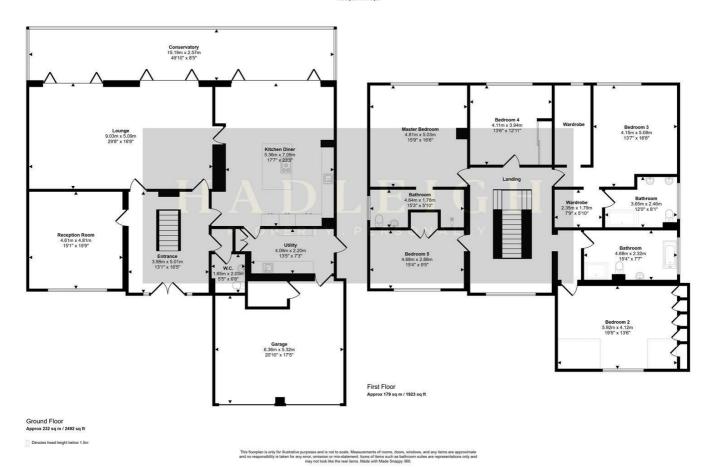

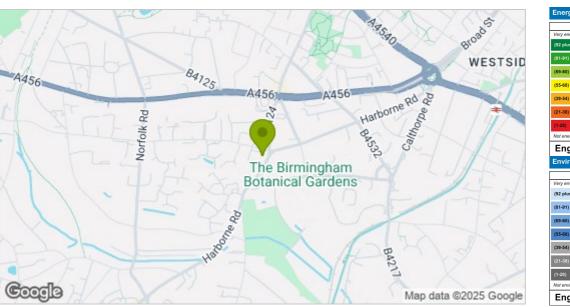

To the rear of the property is a private garden, wrapping around to the side of the property.

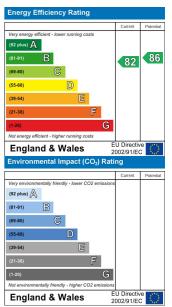
